DISTRICT POLICY CHANGES

2. DISTRICT BOARD

- B. The District Board of Directors shall meet quarterly at such time and place as may be determined by the Board of Directors except that, at the Board's discretion, the meeting in the Second Quarter may be waived if all zones hold zone meetings in that quarter. The First Quarter Meeting shall be held not later than 30 November, the Third Quarter Meeting shall be held in the month of April or May, and the Fourth Quarter Meeting shall be held in conjunction with the Annual District Convention. Notice of all meetings of the District Board of Directors shall be sent by the District Secretary- Treasurer or Convention Chair as determined by the Governor to all members of the Board, with an agenda prepared by the Governor and District Secretary-Treasurer, and the most recent minutes and financial reports, at least thirty days before said meetings. Board Meetings shall be budgeted and conducted under Account 130 and 360 and operated on a break-even basis. Costs of any meals and gratuities may be collected by the Secretary-Treasurer or his/her designate. (OI Bylaws VII, 3, F)
- C. The District Board shall establish those committees it deems appropriate.
