Cut-off for room reservations is July 21! Room rate is \$90.00. The convention registration form is attached, with **registration cut-off August 5**. Registration is \$80.00 (4 meals-usually 2); late registration is \$100.00. **NOTE:** Please make your hotel reservation ASAP (before the cutoff if possible) since the National Route 66 Rally the same weekend will probably fill all hotels in Springfield very quickly. Breakfast Friday, Saturday & Sunday are included with your hotel room reservation. Your convention registration includes Friday lunch and Saturday breakfast, lunch, and dinner but **DOES NOT** include Thursday night or Friday night dinner. We are thrilled to have the Osceola FFA 2021 award-winning student BBQ team cooking pulled pork, barbecue beans, potato salad & cole slaw Friday night so please bring \$10 to pay for that.
